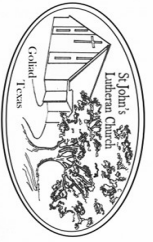

Wednesday, June 11th @ 6:00 in the Fellowship Hall. Council minutes are posted on our website and paper copies are available upon request.

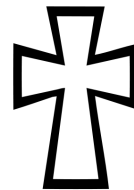
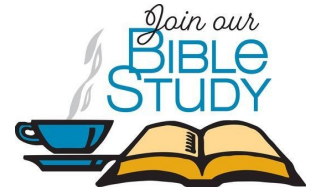


MEN’S FELLOWSHIP BREAKFAST
